Thank you for your letter of July 19 to the Office of Transportation Operations, Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). In your letter, you requested permission to experiment with "Adding Animated Scanning Eyes to the Walk Sign of a Pedestrian Head" at the intersection of 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, NE., and NE. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and the intersection of 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue, NE., and NE. 4<sup>th</sup> Street in downtown Bellevue, Washington.
